



Intern Employment Pathways

When looking for a local internship opportunity in Wichita Falls, TX, you can:

- **Visit the Wichita Falls Chamber Internships [page](#)** for resources on finding an internship, the interview process, evaluating “fit,” and personal stories.
- **Review and update your resume** at Workforce Solutions North Texas for free job placement support.
- **Register with [MyStaf](#), [Spherion](#) and/or [Express Employment](#)** to search for job opportunities.
- **Review internship opportunities** on the Wichita Falls Chamber of Commerce [Job Board](#) and on the state-wide [Texas Internship Challenge](#) website.
- **Schedule mock interviews** with your education institution’s career center.
- **Ask for advice and referrals** from your Academic Advisors, Professors or Teachers.

Midwestern State University Students:

- **Register for Handshake**, also known as [MustangsHire.org](#), for job listings, career advice and resources, and resume and cover letter examples.
- **Visit the Career Closet** for men’s and women’s professional clothing available for interviews & networking events.
- **Review the Campus to Career [Mustangs Survival Guide](#)** for a guide to resume and letter writing, interviewing, job search and career planning success.

Vernon College Students:

- **Register for [CareerCoach](#)** for job listings, career resources, resume building and a free 60-question career assessment.
- **Sign-up for Individual Career Counseling** to assist in making an individualized plan for achieving academic and career success with a Student Success Specialist.

High School Students:

- **Register for Career Cruising** tool to pinpoint key interests, skills, preferences and aspirations.



Be Informed:

- **Research companies** in your field and create a list of organizations you are interested in. If possible, find contact information for someone in a position you would be interested in and request an informational interview. *Tip: Do not send them your resume during this process.*
- **Connect with your personal network** to see if they know of any opportunities at the new location.
- **Visit reputable job search engines** such as [LinkedIn](#), [Indeed](#), and [Glassdoor](#) to begin applying for opportunities.
- **Register for a career specialist** with your local [American Job Center](#).
- **Review wage data** to know what to expect for salary using [Payscale](#).
- **Visit [Vault](#)** for a first-hand look at work within industries, companies, or specific professions to determine your best career fit.
